When you review the Council results on our website you will note that in the first two months of 2017 we achieved:

- Thanks to a significant donation from one donor, we have received \$43,757 in total donations which represents 59% of our annual target
- 8 Councils have already reached their target for 2017
- 25 Councils have made donations in 2017

Each year, each Council is given a target of \$7.00/member. To date, the top five Councils as a percentage of target are:

Contingency Projects - These are projects where funding is raised for a specific purpose in partnership with either the State, Chapter or Council. We now have five Contingency Fund projects underway:

- Champion College Lift - Regina Chapter - assist in funding a lift for handicapped students. This is a part of a major fundraising project to upgrade the Campus facility
- Mark Banga - Monsignor Gerein Council Regina - assist in tuition and costs for his family while attending JP II Institute in Washington DC.
- Coats for Kids - State - Councils can order boxes of coats to distribute in their community or offer donations for distributions elsewhere
- Wheelchair Donations - offer assistance to those in need in less affluent countries
- Columbus Park K of C Monument Landscape 2017 - Resurrection Council 13214 & Regina Chapter - Completing a monument to commemorate the contribution of the Knights of Columbus to youth within the community.
