Sask K of C Charitable Foundation is extremely pleased with Council & member support thus far in 2018

- Total donations reached \$99,384.15 or 119% of target of \$8.00/member. This is a result of a few very generous donations from individual members.
- 25 Councils have reached their target for 2018
- 78 Councils have made a donation to the Foundation in 2018

Wheelchair Purchase – Sask K of C Charitable Foundation has partnered with the State Board on a project designed to provide wheelchairs to churches, community centers etc in partnership with the local Councils. It is our intent to purchase 65 wheelchairs from the Canadian Wheelchair Foundation and then sell them to Councils who will then distribute them to those in need within their community. The wheelchairs will be identified with a permanent Knights logo.
